Some Helpful Information

Available Vaccines

Vaccines recommended for children and adults on the NIP are available at no cost to people with a current Medicare Card. Other vaccines are recommended and are available for a fee.

What to bring

Please bring your child's Personal Health Record book (blue book), Medicare Card and any relevant immunisation history or record cards.

Assessment of Immunisation Records

EHA can provide an assessment of immunisation records for clients residing in our Council areas that have previously been vaccinated by a Doctor (GP) and other immunisation provider either in Australia or Overseas.

Influenza (Flu) Vaccines

Flu vaccines are available at our clinics generally from March to December each year for a fee. You may be eligible for a free flu vaccination as part of the Funded Influenza Program and can contact us for further information and an appointment.

Worksite Immunisation programs

EHA can provide Worksite Immunisation programs for Flu and other non-funded fee vaccines. Our worksite immunisation program can protect your business and staff from the highly-contagious respiratory illnesses caused by Influenza A and B.

At Risk Groups - Aboriginal and MAR*

Free Influenza Vaccine is available for the following groups

Pregnant women, Aboriginal children and adults (subject to eligibility), MAR* persons aged 6 months and older, Persons aged 65 years and older.

*The term Aboriginal is inclusive of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people.

*MAR – Medically at Risk
