

Eastern Health Authority provides vaccines recommended for children and adults on the National Immunisation Program (NIP) at no cost to people with a current Medicare card.

Other vaccines are available for a fee.

Eastern Health Authority (EHA) can assist you and your family with:

Access to public immunisation clinics*

Assessment of immunisation records for people with overseas or incomplete immunisation records

(for residents of EHA council areas only)

Initial enquiries for this service must be made either in person, over the phone or via email. Immunisation assessments cannot be conducted during normal clinic time

Students absent for Year 8 or Year 10 vaccinations in 2021

(schools within EHA council areas only)

Catchup vaccinations for students/under 20-year-olds who go to high school/reside within EHA council areas

Annual flu vaccination including adults and children eligible to receive free flu vaccine under the NIP

Workplace staff immunisation programs

Helpful information

Preparation for clinic

- For all appointments, please arrive 5-10 minutes prior.
- Remember to bring your Medicare card.
- If your child is being vaccinated, please bring their Personal Health Record/blue book.
- If possible, please print, complete and bring your Immunisation Consent Form with you. Forms are attached to booking confirmation email.
- For children under 2 years of age, it is recommended to administer Paracetamol with every dose of Bexsero (Meningococcal B). It is recommended that parents give the first dose 30 minutes prior to immunisation, or as soon as possible after.

- You will be required to wait 15 minutes post vaccination prior to leaving.

Consenting for immunisation

It is a requirement of SA Health that written consent is given prior to immunisation. EHA provides consent forms which must be completed and signed prior to immunisation. Children under 16 years must have parental/legal guardian consent and must provide a consent form signed by a parent/legal guardian prior to immunisation.

Cancelling or changing your appointment

A confirmation email is sent at the time of making an appointment and a courtesy reminder email is sent the day prior to the appointment. Emails contain a link which allows you to self-manage appointment changes or cancellations. Alternatively, you can phone 8132 3600.
