

Important information

Preparation for visit

- Please arrive five minutes prior to appointment time.
- Bring your Medicare card.
- For childhood immunisations, please bring their Personal Health Record/Blue Book.
- If possible, print, complete and bring your immunisation consent form with you. Forms are attached to booking confirmation email.
- It is recommended that children under 2 years of age are given Paracetamol 30 minutes prior to, or as soon as possible after the Bexsero (Meningococcal B) vaccination.
- You will be required to wait 15 minutes post vaccination on site.
- A reminder text message will be sent to the mobile number provided at the time of booking 48 hours before your appointment.

Cancelling or changing your appointment

A booking confirmation email is sent containing a link to allow clients to self manage appointment changes or cancellations. Alternatively, call us on **8132 3600**.

Consenting for Immunisation

To meet SA Health requirements, a completed and signed consent form must be presented prior to immunisation. These can be accessed via the EHA website or on site.

Children under 16 years must be accompanied by a parent/legal guardian.



EHA Immunisation Services

Eastern Health Authority provides vaccines recommended for children and adults on the National Immunisation Program (NIP) at no cost to people with a current Medicare card.

Other vaccines are available for a fee.

Access to public immunisation clinics

An 'out of council area' fee may apply if you are not a resident of the councils listed in directory.

Assessment of immunisation documentation for those with incomplete or overseas records

For residents of EHA council areas only. Initial enquiries for this service must be made either in person, over the phone, via e-mail or online. Immunisation assessments cannot be conducted during normal clinic time.

Please note: All requests for assessment of Immunisation records will incur \$60 admin fee per person for processing. Fee is to be paid prior to commencement of assessment.

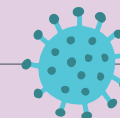
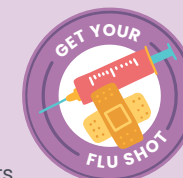

Annual Flu Programs

EHA provides flu vaccinations for adults and children from any area including those eligible to receive free flu vaccine under the National Immunisation Program (NIP) or for a fee for those who are not eligible.

Walk-in:

- All ages above 6 months old

+65 only:

- Dedicated clinic for people 65 years and older

Flu Vaccination Fees

For 5-64 year olds, flu vaccinations cost **\$26 per person**.

Free flu vaccines are available for the following groups:

- Babies and children from 6 months to under 5 years old
- Persons aged 65 years and older
- Pregnant women
- All Aboriginal persons aged 6 months and older (Inclusive of TSI people)
- Medically at Risk persons aged 6 months and older
